### A. 2024-2025 Terms of Reference

The 2024-2025 Terms of Reference were reviewed.

Committee Chair Nazaroff highlighted that the input from partners is valued even though the committee is not a voting committee. Proposed agenda items can be submitted through the Committee Chair to the agenda setting committee for their consideration prior to the agenda setting committee meeting. The agenda setting committee meets two weeks prior to each Education Partner Advisory Committee meeting.

### B. Supporting the Strategic Plan

Superintendent Smillie provided information on the Strategic plan as well as the reporting cycle which is aligned to the strategic priorities. School learning plans are aligned to the Strategic plan, focusing on literacy, numeracy, and a core competency area. Examples were provided of how school learning plans were developed and implemented.

Superintendent Smillie presented the district's coherence model and the Spiral of Inquiry model which is used as a process to focus on continuous improvements in learning for students in the district.

### C. Strategic Priorities Implementation

Attendees were divided into groups who learned about and discussed the following topics at different stations:

- Lifelong Learners: School Learning Plan Grants focusing on literacy/numeracy
- Connected Learners: Environmental and Outdoor Learning
- Caring and Inclusive Learning Culture: Accessibility and Food Equity
- Cultural and Identity Development: Anti-Racism
- Career Development: Inclusive Pathways to Graduation

Superintendent Smillie concluded the item by sharing how the work of schools and the district are aligned with provincial requirements and how reports provide data to allocate resources effectively to support learners.
