

10.7 Physical Restraint and Seclusion Information Physical

restraint and seclusion are guided by information that is in the linked m

inistry document entitled <u>Provincial Guidelines - Physical Restraints and Seclusion</u> in School Settings.

Physical restraint or seclusion is used only in exceptional circumstances where the behaviour of a student poses imminent danger of serious physical harm to self or others and where less restrictive interventions have been ineffective in ending imminent danger of serious physical harm.

Physical restraint is not to be used except as noted above.

Every instance where physical restraint and/or seclusion or the use of "timeout" outside of a classroom has occurred is documented on a Record of Nonviolent Crisis Intervention of a Student and immediately be filed with the principal, the Manager of Safe Schools, and the Assistant Superintendent.
