

Administrative Procedures

AP 3105: Student Withdrawal from School, Program, or Course

Background:

The District understands there may be valid reasons for a student to withdraw from a school, program of studies or from a specific course. In cases of a student withdrawal from a school, program of studies, or course, the student's well-being and success shall be considered paramount.

Procedures:

- 1. A parent or guardian of a student or, when appropriate, the student, shall request permission from the principal or designate to withdraw from the school, program of studies, or course.
- 2. Upon the request of the parent/guardian(s) of the student, or when appropriate, the student, the principal or designate may grant permission to a student to withdraw from the school, program of studies or course when it is determined it is in the best interest of the student.
- 3. In cases where the student requesting the withdrawal is a Nominal Roll student, has a behavioural or low incidence special education designation or is a Child or Youth in Care, the principal shall contact the assistant superintendent prior to granting permission for the withdrawal. The assistant superintendent may request the principal or designate to complete a referral for the student withdrawal to the District Based Team.
- 4. School staff will utilize the student information system withdrawal procedures and complete the BC Student Withdrawal Form as referenced in the MyEducation BC Standards Manual.
